What we do?

The role

The coach needs to be able to demonstrate low level gymnastics skills to the children. The coach will also be responsible for checking safety of the children, taking the register, taking the warmup/games, setting up their gymnastics circuits and side stations in accordance to the theme of the week and lesson plans. The coach will be responsible for 8-10 children in each lesson, teaching them gymnastics based on the weekly theme on the apparatus.
